Lone Feifer participated in the First Indoor Environmental Quality – Global Alliance meeting

Active House was represented at the first General Assembly of the Indoor Environmental Quality – Global Alliance (IEQ-GA) by Lone Feifer, Secretary General of the Active House Alliance.



The meeting has been focused on exchanging views on tackling indoor environment quality in buildings sector and the incorporation of a new global alliance on indoor environmental quality. The aim of the alliance is to provide an acceptable indoor environmental quality to occupants in buildings and places of work around the world and to make sure the knowledge from research on IEQ is implemented in practice.
